

River Lee Country Park

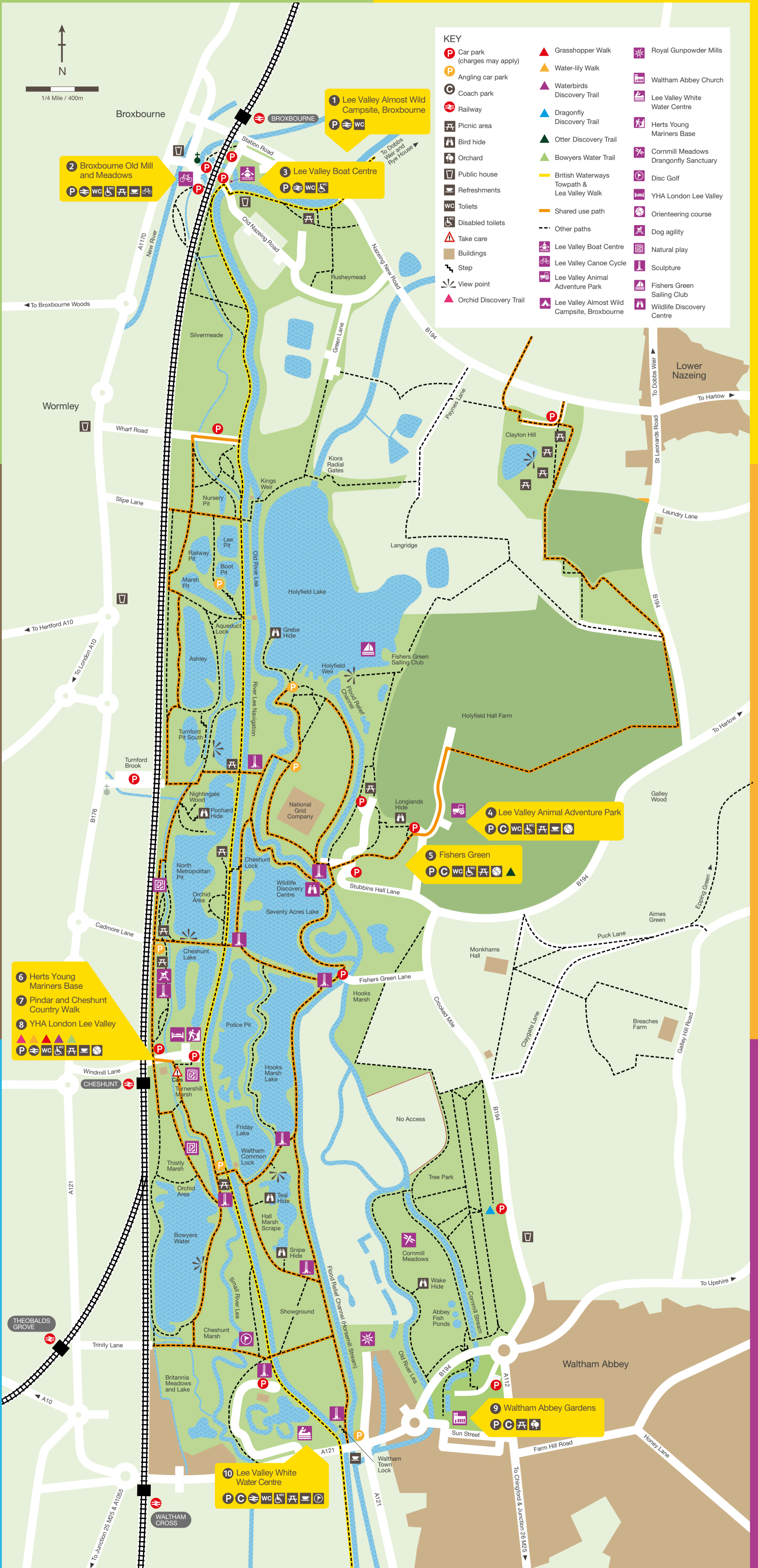
This green open space is ideal for everyone to enjoy the outdoors.
