

- Distance:** 1 mile
- Starting point:** Rammey Marsh car park, Ordnance Road, Enfield, Middlesex EN3 6JN
- Route summary:** A circular route that explores the Bee Orchids of Rammey Marsh
- Terrain:** Grass pathways only with one walk-around gate
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Directions

- Proceed onto the Marsh through the walk-around gate
 - Continue straight across the park to the grass pathway on the left
 - Follow the pathway, continuing north
 - Bear to the right alongside the ditch
 - Turn left up a small incline, leading to the **wildflower meadow** and **Bee Orchids**
 - Retrace the route back to the pathway junction, and continue south, with the **River Lee Navigation** on your left, returning to the car park over the park area
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Things to note

- Public transport links:
 - The closest station is Enfield Lock
 - Buses run along Ordnance Road and Mollison Avenue
