

- Distance:** 1 mile
- Starting point:** Broxbourne Old Mill and Meadows car park, Mill Lane, Broxbourne, Hertfordshire EN10 7AX
- Route summary:** A circular wetland route around Silvermeade. Discover our 'Wind in the Willows', home of the Lee Valley Water Vole
- Terrain:** Grass pathways throughout the route which can become wet and muddy

Directions

- From **Broxbourne Old Mill and Meadows** car park, proceed under the railway bridge and turn right in a south direction down the towpath
 - Turn right through the kissing gate onto **Silvermeade**, and continue along the grass path, parallel to the railway line
 - Cross over the wide wooden bridge, proceeding through the field / kissing gate
 - Turn immediately right, through the wooden gate and proceed across the narrow wooden bridge over the ditch
 - Continue on the grass pathway, bearing to the left and proceed over the bridge and through a kissing gate
 - Turn right, following the grass pathway, with the ditch on the right
 - Proceed through the kissing gate, exiting Silvermeade and turn left onto the towpath
 - Continue north, turning left under the railway bridge returning back to the car park

Things to note

- Public transport links:
 - The closet station is Broxbourne – 5 minutes away from starting point

- Buses run along Nazeing New Road and the B176 which is short distance from the train station
- Car parking charges apply at Broxbourne Old Mill and Meadows car park
- Cattle graze this site during the summer – please keep dogs on leads when the cattle are there
